Templates provide a structured edit that is pre-populated with a collection of media and elements like video, titles, audio, and transitions. Templates can save you time, acting as a guide for structuring your content and can be especially helpful when creating multiple videos of the of the same type.

Here are some tips for getting started with your templates in WeVideo:

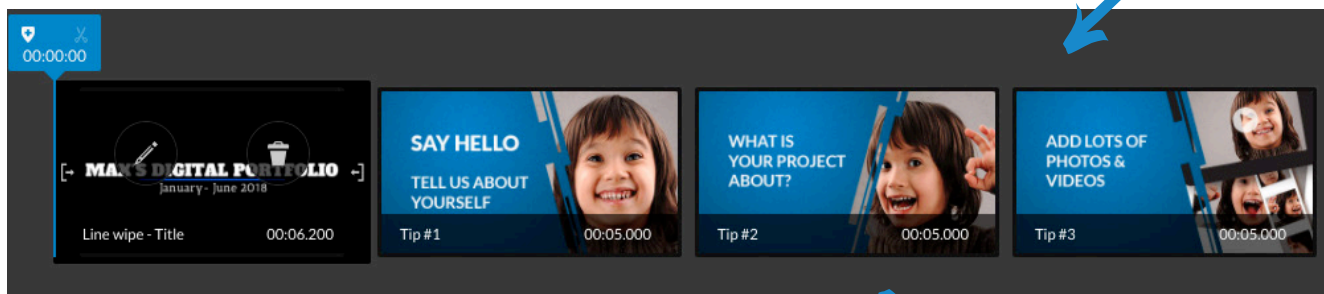
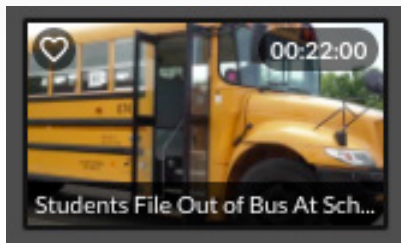
See examples of how to **lay out** and **organize** tracks for a project.

Easily **delete** and **replace** tracks to add your own content.



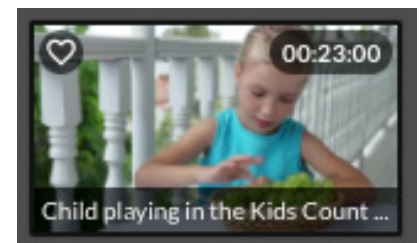
A **“tips track”** helps guide students. You can edit, hide, and delete them.

The **Student Portfolio** template is in **“storyboard mode”** for younger learners. Have students read the prompts and plan out their reflection.



Students can **delete** tip prompts to **add** their videos, photos or voiceovers.

Administrators have the ability to **create** templates and **share** them with all teachers and students associated with their account.
